

AEA EQUIPMENT REPAIR ORDER

Dear Customer,

Thank you for entrusting your equipment to us for repair. Our standard policy is to restore your AEA gear to its original operating specifications.

We generally quote **two weeks** for AEA microphone and preamp repairs, however, if you request cosmetic work this could take up to six weeks to complete.

Please note that for all non-warranty work, at the time the repair order is placed we require a valid credit card to secure the order prior to beginning the work on your microphone or preamp. The credit card will not be charged until the job is complete.

CAUTION: When shipping, please be sure to pack your microphone carefully, with an ample amount of cushioning. It is necessary to support 44 grilles carefully to prevent damage during shipping. AEA is not responsible for damage incurred while shipping.
